

## PRIMARY ELECTION – March 5, 2024

**PURPOSE:** To provide non-partisan voter information showing where candidates stand on the issue of “Pro-Life”. Candidates who hold a pro-life view also tend to support the other freedoms stated within the Constitution of the United States.

<p><b>PROPOSITION 1 - Behavioral Health Services Program and Bond Measure (March 2024)</b> This Proposition would authorize \$6.38 billion in general obligation bonds to be used for mental health services and homeless housing including a portion for homeless veterans. Payed back \$310 million annually for 30 years totaling \$9.3 billion.</p> <p><b>Recommend Vote No</b> – Even if such services could be shown to be effective as administered by the state of California, such services should be a part of the annual state budget, not based on borrowing 30 years into the future.</p>
