Prop 1	This is a Constitutional Amendment that would create a “right” to abortion in the California Constitution.	The “right to abortion” claim ignores the “right to life” of the pre-born. When do their rights begin?	No
Prop 26	Legalizes sports betting and racetracks in California Indian casinos.	Expanding gambling is wrong for all of us.	Recommend No
Prop 27	Legalizes out of state online sports betting.	Promises to fund homeless projects by expanding online gambling but these are hollow promises by those who will gain through the loss of others.	Recommend No
Prop 28	Requires funding for K-12 art and music education.	A back door way to increase tax revenue for the public schools.	Recommend No
Prop 29	Requires more staffing requirements, reporting requirements, ownership disclosure, and closing requirements for private dialysis clinics.	Back again for another try, backed by unions, this is more costly government intrusion into private business.	Recommend No
Prop 30	A yes vote increases the tax on personal income above \$2 million by 1.75%. The revenue is to be used to fund zero-emission vehicle projects and wildfire prevention efforts.	California voters do not have the right to vote a tax increase on fellow citizens.	Recommend No
Prop 31	A yes vote upholds the ban on flavored tobacco sales in California.	Smoking is bad for one’s health but this is more government intervention in private enterprise.	Recommend No

1. The California Pro-Life PAC is associated with the California Pro-life Council which is the California affiliate of the National Right to Life Committee since 1971. CPLC is a non-profit, non-partisan, non-sectarian grassroots organization dedicated to restoring legal protection for vulnerable individual lives, particularly those at risk of abortion, infanticide, and euthanasia.
